

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING SUNRISE UNIVERSITY, ALWAR, RAJASTHAN

AND IIMT COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING GREATER NOIDA, UTTAR PRADESH

FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF ACADEMIC COOPERATION IN ACADEMIC INTEREST

The general objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to stimulate and facilitate the development of collaborative and mutually beneficial programmes which serve to enhance the intellectual life and cultural development on both campuses, and to contribution to increased interstate cooperation. Thus, SUNRISE UNIVERSITY, ALWAR, RAJASTHAN and ILMT COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING, GREATER NOIDA, UTTAR PRADESH and have agreed that in support of their mutual interests in the field of education:

The two Educational Institutions will:

- a) cooperate in the exchange of information relating to their activities in Teaching, Guidance & Counseling in fields of mutual interests;
- b) endeavor to encourage students and staff to spend some time in the host Institution/University. The exchange of students will be dependent on the execution of a formal Student Exchange Agreement prior to commencement of this activity:
- c) conduct short courses, as mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity:
- d) conduct cultural projects, a, mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity:
- e) conduct study tours, a, mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity.
- f) Cooperation in conducting the Seminars, Workshops, Webinars, FDPs, e FDPs, Short Term Certificate Courses, FPDPs, Moot Court Competitions, National Law Debates, Youth Parliament Competitions, or any other Management, IT or Law related Academic Events.
- g) The aim of the Memorandum of Understanding shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both Institutions.

The host institution agrees to assist in the seeking of appropriate housing, and to supply work space, library and technical facilities as appropriate.

In the implementation of specific cooperative programmes, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects including funding and the obligations to be undertaken by each party will be negotiated, mutually agreed and formalized in writing, prior to the commencement of the program.

This agreement will take effect from the date of its signing and shall be valid up to 31-07-2022 from that date unless sooner terminated, revoked of modified by mutual written agreement between tile Parties, and may be extended by mutual written agreement.

Either party may terminate the Agreement at any time during tile term by the provision of three months written notice to the other party.
