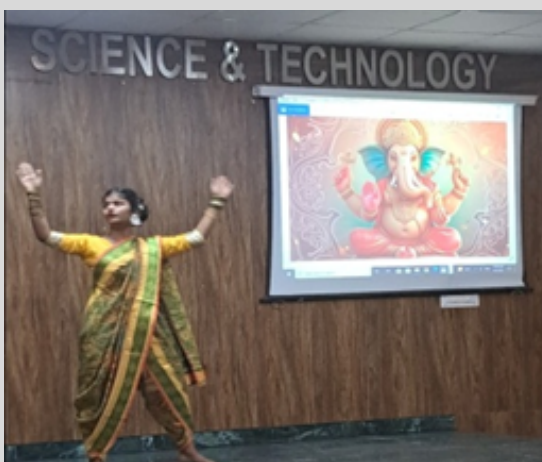


PAYING TRIBUTE

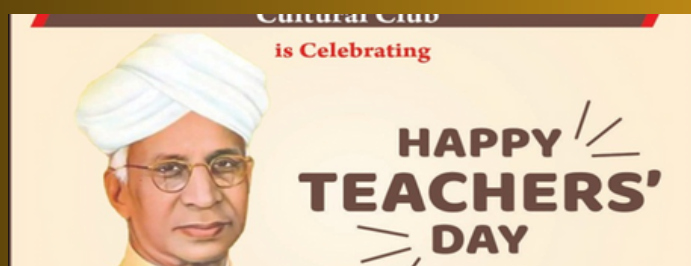

Social Media Censorship: A Threat to Freedom of Speech & Expression?

“Freedom of speech is not a license to abuse, it is a responsibility!”

In today's world, social media has become a powerful force that impacts our daily lives, influences communities, and even drives social change. With such vast capabilities and a highly interconnected audience, social media platforms, alongside regulatory bodies, bear a responsibility to strictly monitor and regulate content. This ensures the prevention of misinformation and hate speech, without letting the notion of absolute free speech stand in the way.

Many advocates of unrestricted freedom of speech often overlook the fact that no right is absolute. In a functioning democracy, every right, including free speech, must have reasonable limits to avoid misuse and promote responsible behavior. As the saying goes, "Absolute power corrupts absolutely." While individuals should freely exercise their rights, it must not infringe upon others' liberties or threaten national interests.

The Indian Constitution, under Article 19(1)(a), guarantees freedom of speech but also allows for reasonable restrictions in the interest of sovereignty, public order, morality, and national security. The balance between liberty and responsibility is also emphasized in the Preamble, which champions both “liberty of thought and expression” and “fraternity” for the unity of the nation. The real question we need to ask ourselves is: “Freedom of speech, but at what cost?” Should it come at the expense of public order, national security, or the spread of misinformation? As much as social media provides a platform for open expression, it must be monitored to ensure it remains a safe and positive space for all.

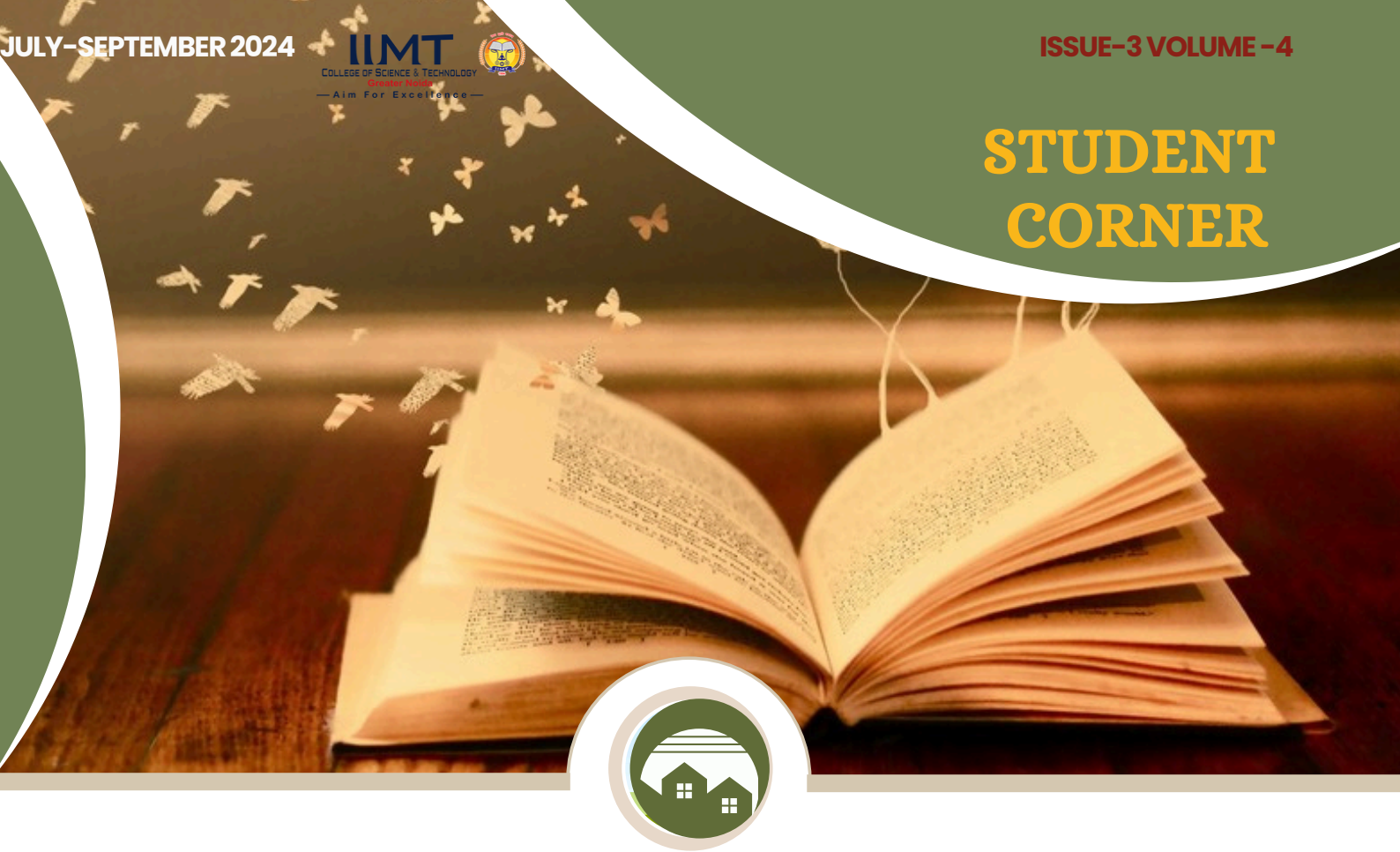
