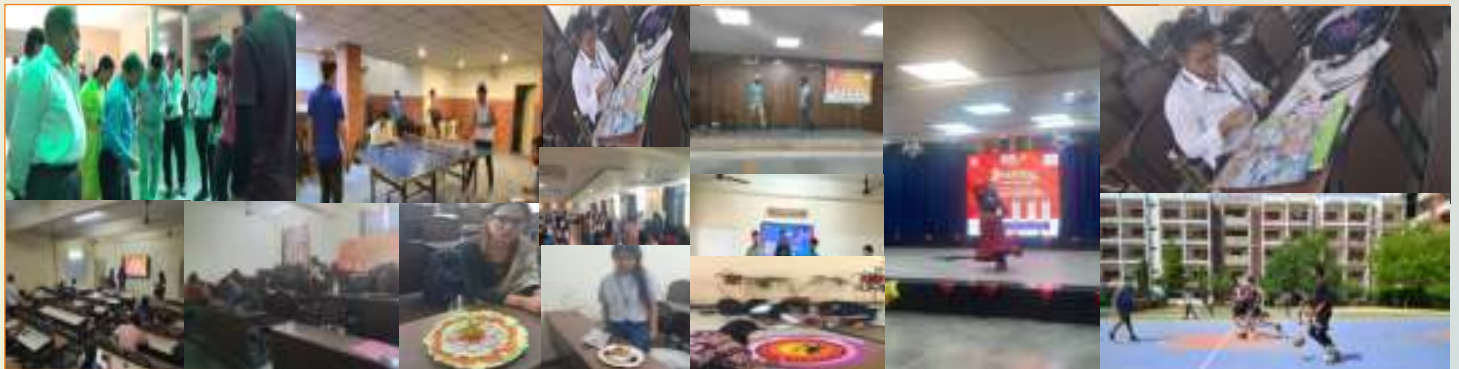
As we look ahead, let us carry forward this momentum with enthusiasm and purpose. The best is yet to come, and I am honored to be on this journey with all of you.

IIMT College of Science and Technology organized a one week Language workshop for B.ED. First year students. This workshop was an essential part of their syllabus. The main objective for organizing this workshop was to strengthen the ability of pupil teacher to read correctly, pronunciation, write correctly and communicate correctly. The workshop was aimed mainly to encourage young pupil teachers to learn and explore the spoken Hindi and English skills to enhance their communication skill. First day was mainly focused on discussion about the importance of language learning. The coordinator Dr. Sharia Dalal gave a brief introduction on the concept and meaning of language, its importance. The coordinators elaborated on how human being communicated in earlier times. There was also discussion on how importance a good communication is for sharing of thoughts and articulation of ideas. A discussion on barriers to a healthy communication and how to overcome them also took place. This emphasized the importance of practicing the language one wants to learn, in order to develop thinking in that language. The students were told about the production of sounds through phonetics. The coordinator also discussed about vowels and consonants. The coordinators kept the students engaged throughout the process by involving them in activities. Through this session which was mainly focused on parts of speech in English and basic grammar. Workshop was concluded with discussion with students on what they learnt and if it was a helpful session. All of them agree that they learnt useful skills in the workshop that would help them in the future, and that the workshop increased their knowledge.
