She cautioned that while AI offers valuable support in data analysis and interpretation, it should complement, rather than replace, the nuanced insights and contextual understanding that human researchers bring to qualitative research.

Throughout her presentation, Dr. Rajan provided practical examples and case studies demonstrating the synergistic use of AI and qualitative research tools. She illustrated how researchers can leverage AI to streamline workflow processes, improve data accuracy, and uncover meaningful patterns in qualitative data analysis.

Participants in the session gained insights into optimizing research methodologies through AI integration, understanding its potential benefits and limitations in qualitative research contexts. Dr. Rajan's discussion underscored the evolving landscape of research practices, highlighting the transformative potential of AI as a collaborative tool for advancing qualitative research methodologies in academia and beyond.
