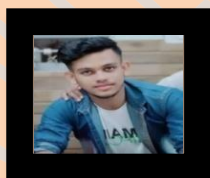

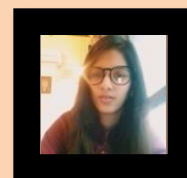

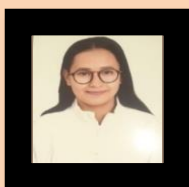

## **“CULTURAL COMPETENCE IN THE BUSINESS WHAT AN ENTREPRENEUR NEED TO KNOW”**

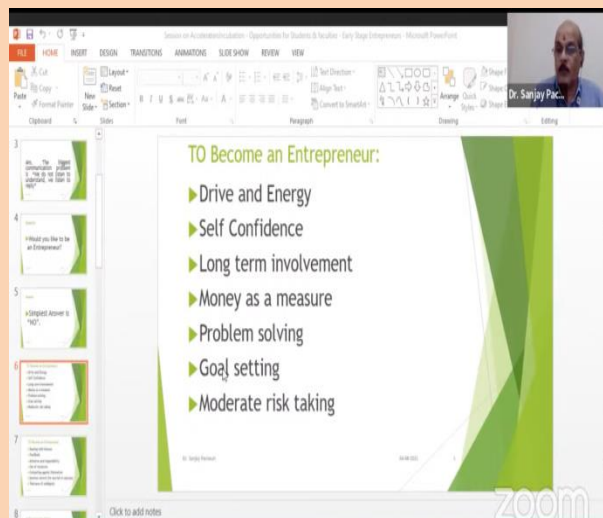

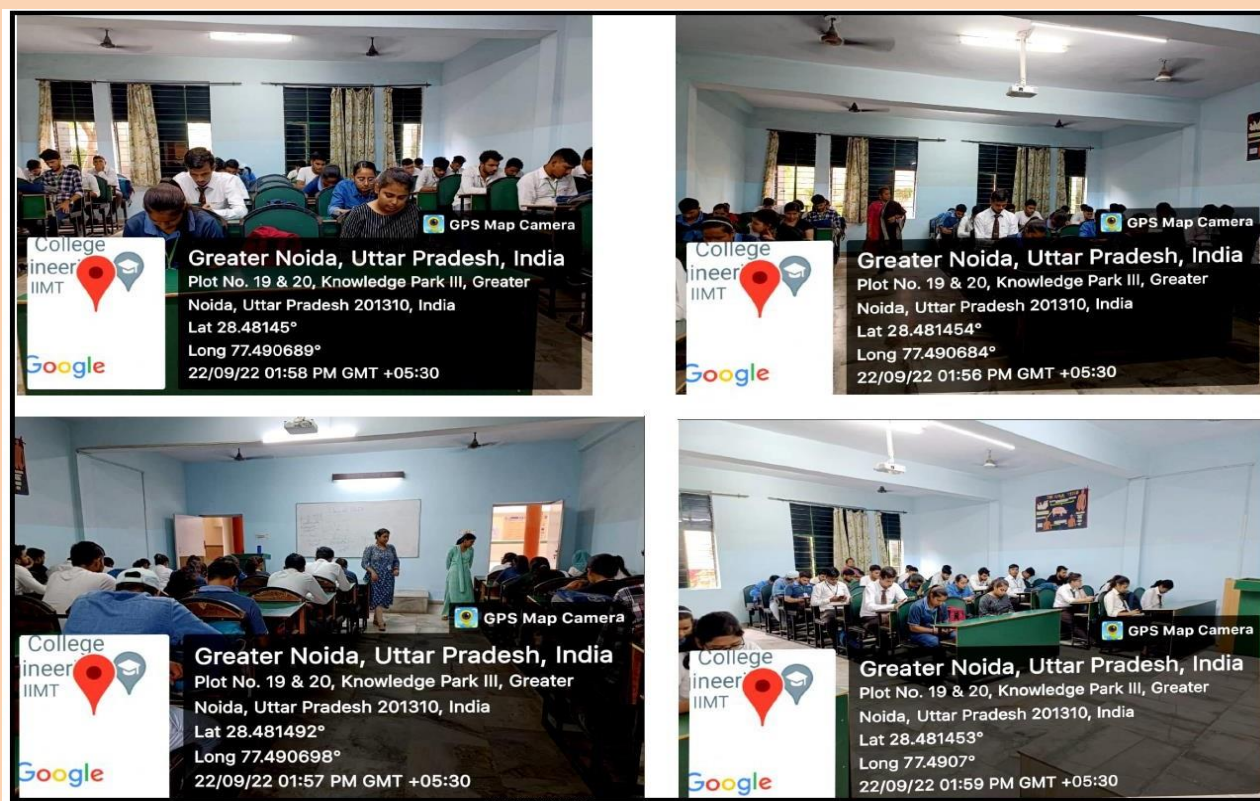

# PHARMACOVIGILANCE WEEK

A Pharmacovigilance week was celebrated from 17<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> September 2022. The program was organized by drug monitoring centre, IIMT college of Pharmacy. The theme for this year's National Pharmacovigilance Week is "Encouraging reporting of ADR by Patients".



Mysore; 184 reports from UCMS-GTBH, Delhi; 167 reports from LHMC, New Delhi.

Adverse events reported by PV system potentially benefit to the community due to their proximity to both population and public health practitioners, in terms of language and knowledge, enables easy contact with reporters by electronically. Hence, PV helps to the patients get well and to manage optimally or ideally, avoid illness is a collective responsibility of industry, drug regulators, clinicians and other healthcare professionals to enhance their contribution to public health. Hence, Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission has decided to celebrate "Pharmacovigilance week" on the occasion of patient safety day in order to make the public and healthcare professionals aware about the importance of ADR reporting to improve patient safety.

Some activities that can be undertaken are—

1. **For Common Public:** Carrying out Community level awareness program regarding safe use of medicines, how to report suspected ADRs and tools to report by ADR Monitoring Centre's.
2. **Professional organizations and institutions:** Arrange an educational/training program including Poster, animation or video Competition, Quiz, workshops, conferences, Essay writing and debate competition for students and academicians where they can educate professional's, young leaders about the Importance of Pharmacovigilance to maximize drug safety. Also we would like to suggest the institutions to facilitate the participants with the appreciation certificates.
3. **Student, fellow health professional:** We can share the activities undertaken regarding pharmacovigilance on social media platforms like Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn.

#### National Pharmacovigilance week (NPW)

Celebrating the National Pharmacovigilance Week from 17<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2022

#### Theme: Encouraging reporting of ADR by patient

National Coordination Centre, Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission, is pleased to announce the official celebration of "National Pharmacovigilance Week" from 17<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> September to be celebrated every year on this week to recognize the eminent role of pharmacovigilance in detection, assessment, understanding and prevention of adverse effects or any other drug-related problem.

Pharmacovigilance (PV) plays a key role in the healthcare system through assessment, monitoring and discovery of interactions amongst drugs and their effects in human. Pharmaceutical and biotechnological medicines are designed to cure, prevent or treat diseases; however, can cause adverse drug reactions (ADRs) to patients. Thus, for safety medication ADRs monitoring required for each medicine throughout its life cycle, during development of drug such as pre-marketing including early stages of drug design, clinical trials, and post-marketing surveillance. PV is concerned with the detection, assessment, understanding and prevention of ADRs.

Pharmacogenetics and pharmacogenomics are an indispensable part of the clinical research. Variation in the human genome is a cause of variable response to drugs and susceptibility to diseases are determined, which is important for early drug discovery to PV. This necessitates an utmost requirement for effective regulations of the drug approval process and conscious pre and post approval vigilance of the undesired effects, especially in India.

Adverse drug reaction monitoring centers (AMCs) under PvPL play a vital role in the collection and follow-up of ADR reports from the patients. They are responsible for collecting the adverse event information from the patients, performing follow-up with them to check the completeness of the ADR reports as per Standard. In total, NCC received 3,537 Individual Case Safety Reports (ICSRs) and 1,948 Adverse Events Following Immunization (AEFI) from the AMCs in the month of May 2014. Out of 97 AMCs where the Vigiflow is functional, 82 centres have provided the ADR's reports via Vigiflow. It was observed that PGIMER, Chandigarh entered the highest number of ADR's reports (311 reports in May 2014) followed by 225 reports from MMC, Chennai; 216 reports from JSS,
