
 Webinar on Practical Implications of Start-Up in Legal Sector


Under this lecture how does IPR work and why is it important for any country and those who invent or get royalty through it when anyone uses it.

She elaborately discussed the ideological positions taken by rich industrialized western European Countries and Patent waiver as demanded by countries like India and South Africa.


Dr. Tanushree (Ph.D.,JRF), Assistant Professor, college of law as resource person explained the process of writing a research paper and coved the issues like
