About MMTTC
Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre (MMTTC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi under UGC, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India (formerly Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMNMNTT) scheme) was inaugurated by Hon'ble Chairman of UGC Prof. M. Jagdish Kumar. The vision of this centre is to develop skills & competencies in the higher education faculty members for better teaching, learning and research in line with NEP 2020. This Centre as TLC has successfully organized 64 programmes. This Centre has also conducted 83 Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching (ARPT) courses through SWAYAM in Sanskrit discipline and has published 62 handbooks for teaching Sanskrit. Our MMTTC since its inception in September 2023 has successfully organized 55 programmes viz. 09 One Week Faculty Development Programme (08 in online and 01 in offline mode), 03 One Month Mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (online mode), 08 Two Weeks Refresher Course (online mode) and 35 Eight Days NEP Orientation & Sensitization programmes till now.

About IMT College of S&T
IMT College of Science & Technology, Greater Noida, came into existence after receiving recognition from NCTE for offering teacher education courses to a unit of 100 B.Ed. students during the academic session of 2006-07. The college also runs a B.Sc. in Computer Science, which came into existence in 2019. B.Sc. Computer Science is a popular specialized program at IMT College of Science & Technology offering a full-time, 3-year course. It covers computing fundamentals, database systems, and advanced language courses. The college is situated at Plot No. 20, Knowledge Park III, and Greater Noida. It is recognized by NCTE and affiliated with C.C.S. University, Meerut. It is a self-financed college, managed by seven Rotarians, all devoted to the service of humanity and the betterment of society. The college is a self-financed college, with a view to molding and shaping prospective teachers to be competent to impart curricular experiences to the students of secondary schools and to produce quality teachers with great values so that they could contribute to the task of nation-building. The college is achieving this goal with the assistance of highly qualified teaching educators, CCU University, Meerut, academically governs it. The college has a rich library with the latest reading, research, and reference material. Besides enriching teachers' and students' knowledge, the college has a psychological laboratory, an education technology laboratory, a language laboratory, a physical science laboratory, an applied physics laboratory, an electronics laboratory, an art and craft laboratory, a sports room, a music room, a seminar hall, a conference hall, a multipurpose hall, and open spaces for different purposes. The formation of curriculum is done through interactive classroom teaching, seminars, workshops, quizzes, and discussions in guest lectures. The college has been trying to keep up with changing behavior to produce sincere and dedicated teachers and groom them into motivated, creative, responsible, and independent people.

Backdrop
As we all know that the capacity building of faculty across all levels of Higher Education is one of the thrust areas of quality & excellence in education which is well catered through training programmes conducted by HRDC's of UGC & various Centres under PMNMNTT scheme. In keeping view the optimal utilization of infrastructure, human & financial resources, the Ministry of Education (MOE) has sought that synergy & integration between these two Centres should be strengthened and the entire capacity building effort to be reformed & popularized as Malaviya Mission through Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP) which was inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister of Education Sh. Dharmendra Pradhan on 5th September 2023. To implement this programme, 113 institutions (66 HRDC & 45 PMNMNTT) were identified as Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centres. Each Centre has to conduct 36 Programmes per year which can be classified into 4 types of programmes viz. 24-NEP Orientation & Sensitization, 2-FDPs, 5-Short-Term Programmes, & 5-Refresher Programmes. In this backdrop, the 08 days online national NEP Orientation & Sensitization Programme is being organized with an intent to orient & sensitize Higher Education faculty on the 10 key themes of NEP-2020 viz. Holistic and Multidisciplinary Education; Indian Knowledge Systems; Academic Leadership, Governance, and Management; Higher Education and Society; Research and Development; Skill Development; Student Diversity & Inclusive Education; Autonomy to the institution & choice to the students; Curriculum, Development, Pedagogy & Assessment and Information & Communication Technology.

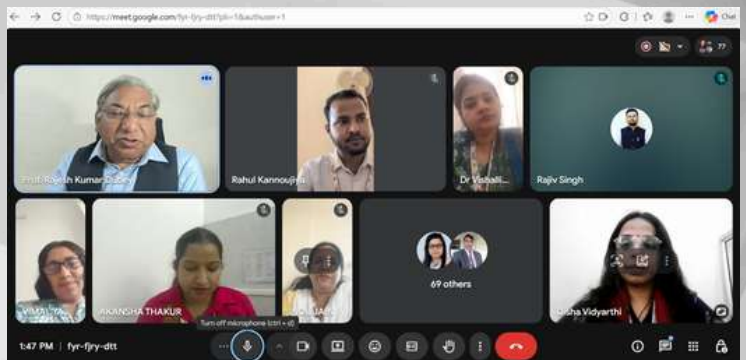
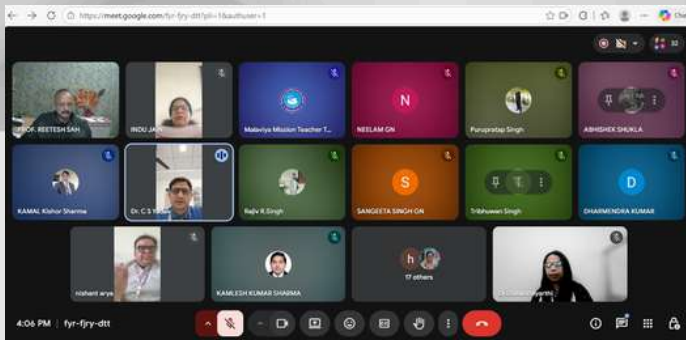

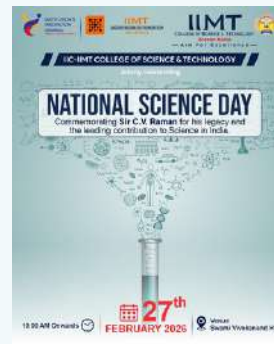

Innovation & Entrepreneurship Activities (Jan-March 2025)

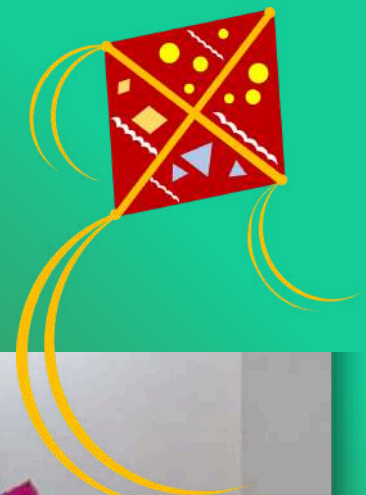

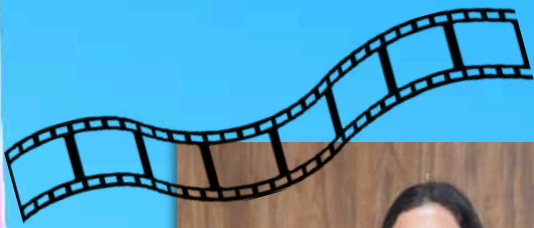
Soaring high with Creativity and Celebration!

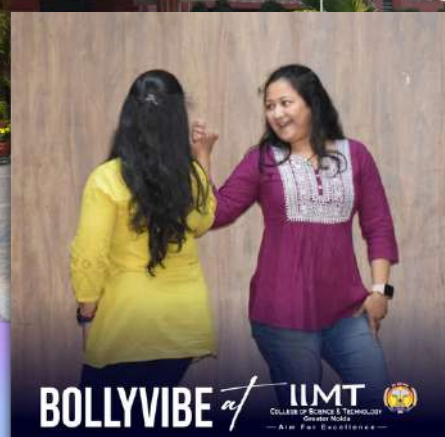
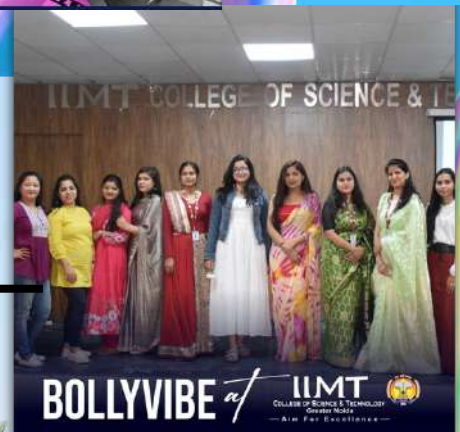

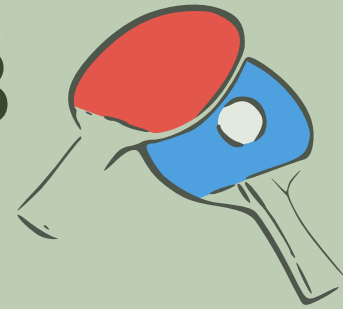

ना कमाने का डर ,

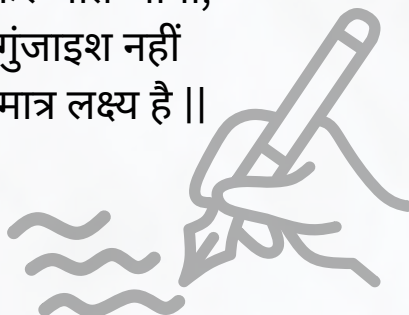
सबके अरमानों के टूटने का डर,
