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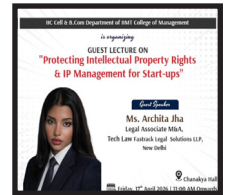
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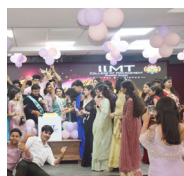

Private Medical Colleges Cannot Be Forced to Charge Government Fees: Supreme Court

The Supreme Court has ruled that private medical colleges cannot be compelled to charge the same fees as government colleges, remarking that doing so could force private institutions to shut down at a time when the country critically needs doctors. With these observations, the top court declined to interfere with a petition challenging the fee structure of private medical colleges in Rajasthan.

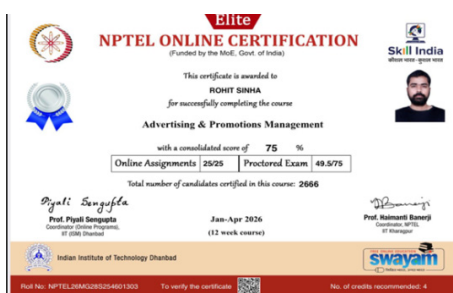
A bench comprising Justice B.V. Nagarathna and Justice Joymalya Bagchi was hearing a petition challenging an order passed by the Rajasthan High Court. The petitioner had argued that annual tuition fees in Rajasthan's private medical colleges range from ₹18.90 lakh to ₹25 lakh, which is not aligned with the ₹8 lakh annual income threshold set for the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category. However, the apex court observed that self-financed institutions cannot be expected to match the fee structures of government institutions, noting that self-financing inherently means operating on self-sustained financial models. Compelling them to adopt government fee models could end their contribution to medical education and drive them to close or pivot to other sectors. Regarding student choices, Justice Nagarathna highlighted that students who have the financial capacity can pay the fees, while those who cannot afford them can opt for alternatives such as scholarships, financial assistance, or securing admission in government medical colleges. Addressing arguments referencing the National Medical Commission (NMC) office memorandum dated February 3, 2022—which recommended capping fees for 50% of seats in private colleges and deemed universities at government rates—the court noted that the state of Rajasthan had not implemented the memorandum, while adding that a separate petition challenging the NMC guidelines remains pending before the Supreme Court.

The Supreme Court ultimately dismissed the petition, upholding previous rulings by both the single and division benches of the High Court. The High Court had earlier noted that EWS reservations under the 103rd Constitutional Amendment apply to the admission process and do not grant a statutory right to concessional fees in private medical colleges without explicit legal provisions. The case stemmed from a 22-year-old NEET-UG aspirant from the general category holding an EWS certificate, who did not select private colleges in the first two counseling rounds but later opted for the EWS category in the third round following an interim High Court order, subsequently

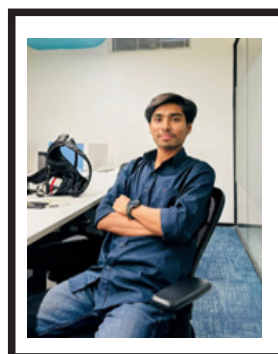

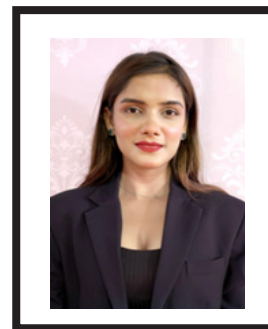

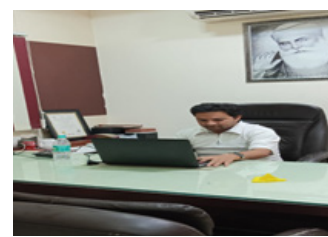
