About the Event:

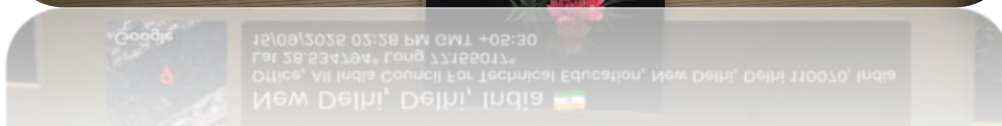
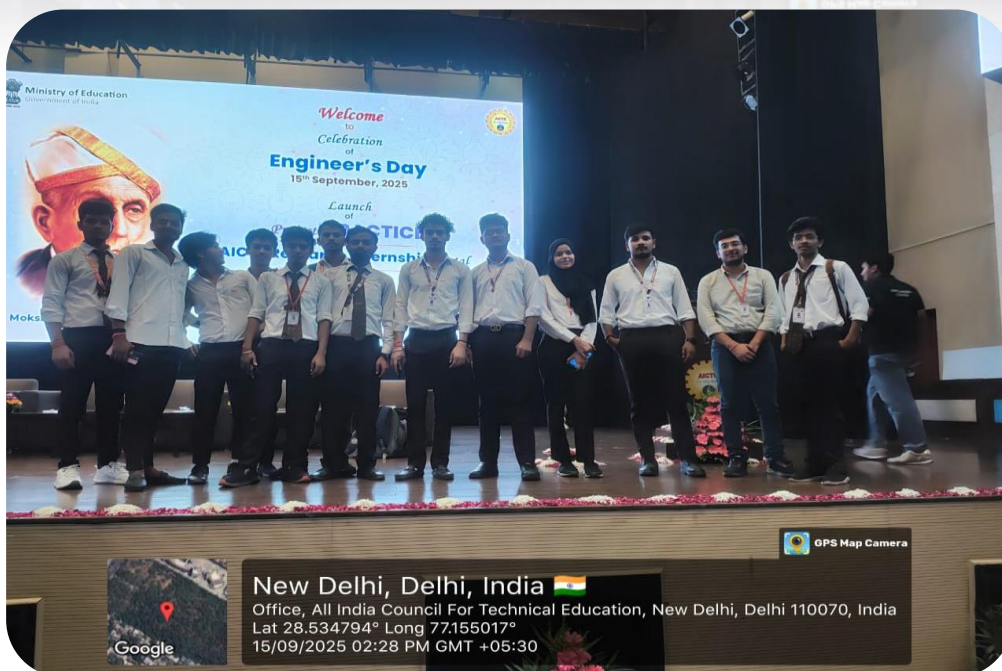
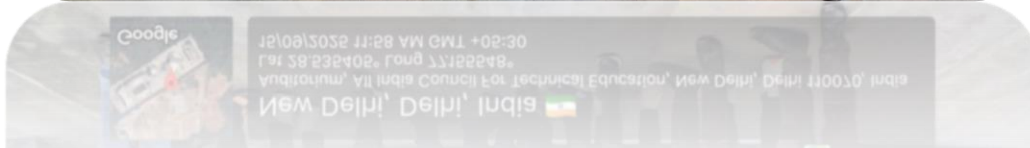
1. **Students:** Final-year students of EE, ME, CE departments gained exposure to national-level policy initiatives and employability-driven programmes.
