Guest-lectures and visiting professors from various universities and colleges were assigned typical legal topics to sort out difficulties of subjects and papers. Conferences and Seminars were conducted on prior interval to address the demand of quality material on professional topics of legal values. Faculty members were motivated to be more regular and shed the habit of availing leaves for petty issues so that they could pay more attention to academic matters. Extra classes were conducted on weekend to provide all students better glimpse of course material. Unit-tests were frequently conducted in addition to Sessional examinations and Pre University examinations. Many legal activities were conducted on regular interval to sustain the interest of the students in both academic and non academic activities. Smart mode of education was adopted to counter the harshness of difficult topics. Hence, lectures through PPTs in smart classes were given weightage so that easy grasping of ideas may be ensured by the institution for the betterment of the student.
