

## Eligibility Criteria for Admission to Law Programme

### (Three-Year. and Five-Year Integrated Law Programmers')

This is to inform all prospective applicants those admissions to the **Three-Year LL.B. Programme** and the **Five-Year Integrated LL.B. Programme** for the academic year 2025-26 shall be governed by the eligibility criteria prescribed below, in accordance with the rules of the Bar Council of India and the University norms.

#### 1. Three-Year LL.B. Programme

A candidate shall be eligible for admission to the Three-Year LL.B. Programme if he/she:

- Has successfully completed a **Bachelor's Degree** in any discipline from a recognized university.
- Has secured a **minimum of 45% marks Gen & 42% OBC** (40% in case of SC/ST Persons with Disabilities or as per applicable norms) in the qualifying examination.
- Fulfils any additional requirements as may be prescribed by the University/Admission Authority from time to time.

#### 2. Five-Year Integrated

A candidate shall be eligible for admission to the Five-Year Integrated LL.B. Programme if he/she:

- Has successfully completed **10+2 or equivalent examination** from a recognized board.
- Has secured a **minimum of 45% marks Gen & 42% OBC** (40% in case of SC/ST Persons /Persons with Disabilities or as per applicable norms) in the qualifying examination.
- Meets the age and other eligibility conditions, if any, prescribed by the competent authority.

#### General Conditions

- Admission shall be subject to verification of original documents at the time of admission.
- Candidates appearing in the qualifying examination may apply provisionally, subject to submission of proof of eligibility before the prescribed date.
- The institution reserves the right to amend the eligibility criteria in accordance with statutory or regulatory requirements.

All applicants are advised to carefully read the admission brochure and ensure that they meet the eligibility criteria before applying.
