IQAC was organized an Expert Lecture on “Goal & Role of IQAC for NAAC & NBA” on **15th June, 2023**.

The primary aim of IQAC is **“To promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of best practices”**.

Functions of NAAC

Periodic assessment and accreditation of institutions of higher education. Stimulate the academic environment for the promotion of the quality of teaching-learning and research in higher education institutions. Encourage self-evaluation, accountability, autonomy and innovations in higher education.

Functions of NBA

Accreditation is a process of quality assurance and improvement, whereby a program is critically appraised to verify that the program continues to meet and / or exceeds the norms and standards prescribed by the regulatory authority from time to time.

NBA does not accredit institutions, instead, it accredits the programs offered by technical / professional institutions which have graduated at least two batches. During the calendar year 2022, 2192 programs were considered for accreditation, out of which 2016 programs were accredited and remaining 176 programs were not accredited.
